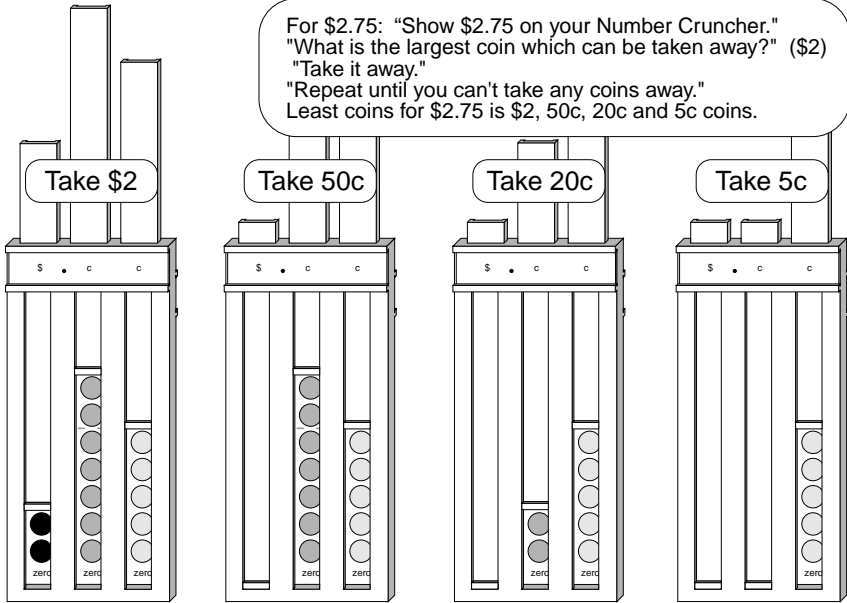

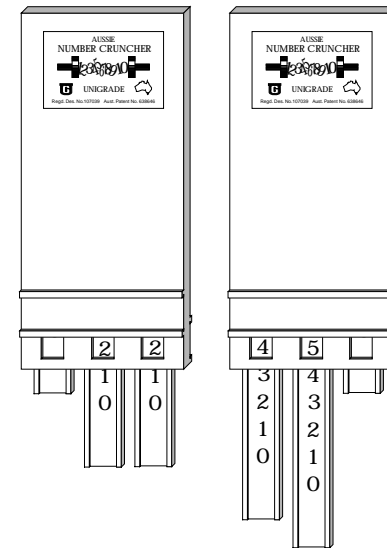
# LEAST NUMBER OF COINS

For \$2.75: "Show \$2.75 on your Number Cruncher."  
"What is the largest coin which can be taken away?" (\$2)  
"Take it away."  
"Repeat until you can't take any coins away."  
Least coins for \$2.75 is \$2, 50c, 20c and 5c coins.

# 24 HOUR TIME



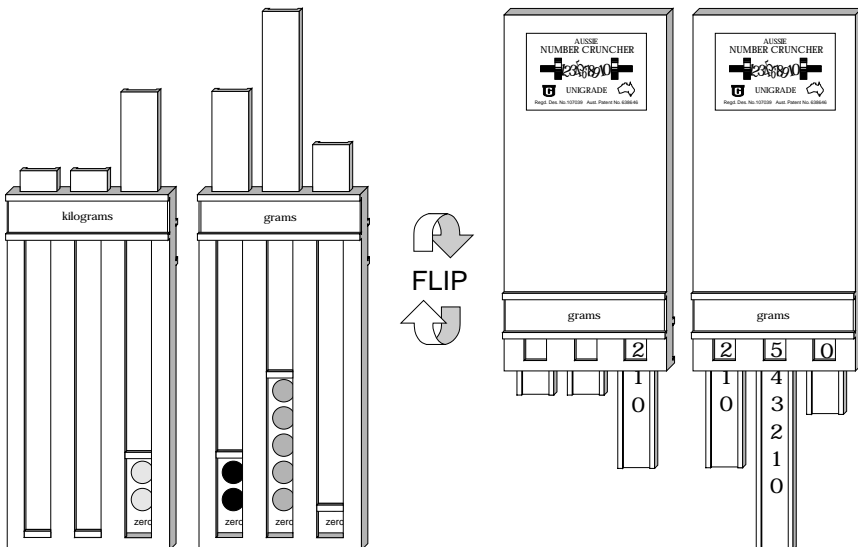
"Show me a quarter to eleven at night in twenty-four hour time." (2245 hours)

"Show 4:00 p.m. in twenty-four hour time." (1600 hours)  
"Show 6:00 a.m. in twenty-four hour time." (0600 hours)

# KILOGRAMS - GRAMS

"Show 2 1/4 kg in kilograms and grams on the front."  
"How many grams is that altogether?"  
"Flip and check the answer on the back."  
"Use decimals to write 2 1/4 kg."



PLACE VALUE

# TONNES - KILOGRAMS

"Show 4 213 kg on the front of your Number Cruncher."  
"How many tonnes and kilograms would that be?" (4 t 213 kg)  
"How many more kilograms would you need to make 5 tonnes?"
