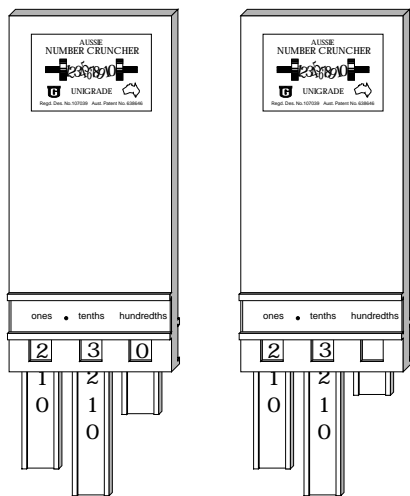

"Don't forget to eliminate any unnecessary zeros."

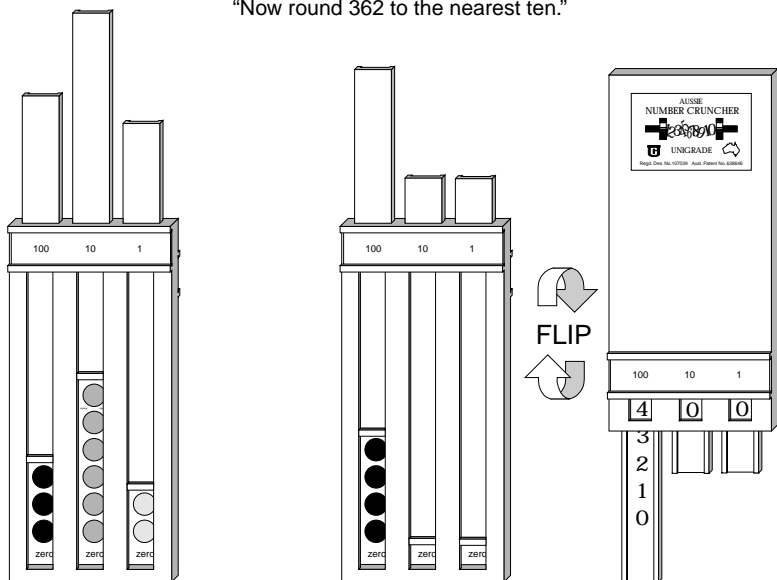
"Show 193 hundredths and add 37 hundredths."
